

# Curriculum planning task as preparation for a school placement

All primary school subjects, topics and themes can support financial education.

Manchester Metropolitan, Hull and Edge Hill universities were keen to deliver sessions on financial education curriculum planning to illustrate how easily this aspect of the curriculum can be embedded into the pupils' education entitlement.

## Example task:

- Identify a subject/theme/topic to be delivered e.g. **The Victorians.**
- With reference to the **Primary Planning Framework** at [www.pfeg.org/ppf](http://www.pfeg.org/ppf), select 2 or 3 age/ability related learning outcomes which support this subject/topic.
- Plan an activity to ensure that the desired financial education learning outcomes are achievable.
- Consider how you might build in assessment.

**This was a good example of how a popular topic could be used at Key Stage 2 to explore:**

1. How to manage money,
2. How finance plays an important part in people's lives.

Activities were developed to help the pupils to compare and contrast how people in a different place and time budgeted for the things they needed and how this compares with how we do this today.
